## **Discussion/Action Items:**

- A. Discuss/ Approve Cleanup Day Request James Nixon (Action) There is quite a bit of trash along HWY 7. James Nixon stated that we live in a beautiful city and he would like to help clean it up. He has the help of the local softball team. He has requested from the city traffic control and safety equipment to keep the kids safe and trash bags. Councilmember Stephen Rowe proposes providing water and ice. With the help of the Kamiah Fire and Rescue, we would like to help in this spring clean-up. - B. Due to the possibility of the city park being unavailable, 3 Rivers Amateur Radio Club has decided to move their event this year and revisit their proposal next year. No action is needed.

- E. Discuss/ Approve Chief Arsenault attendance at the Idaho Fire Chief's Meeting- Conference is for 4 days @ \$100. per day, with 3 meals per day included. Lodging is for 6 days at an estimated cost of \$800. Motion to approve the application was made by Councilmember Genese Simler and seconded by Councilmember Stephen Rowe.
